

A duffle bag or a military A3 bag would be best for packing the following gear. Each scout is responsible for his personal gear. Sleeping bags should be packed in a drawstring stuff sack or rolled and secured with pack straps. Please see the Optional Gear List for more "Creature Comforts" type gear.

- \* Underwear - 3 pair
- \* Wool Socks - 4 pair - 2 pair per day
- \* Thermal underwear - 3 pair
- \* T-shirt - 4 pair
- \* Long sleeve shirt - 3 pair
- \* Jeans - 4 pair
- \* Snow/Ski pants or Coveralls - 1 pair
- \* Winter Coat with hood
- \* Ski/Stocking Cap – 2 - 1 for day and 1 for sleep
- \* Gloves/Mittens - 2 pair
- \* Snow boots
- \* Raingear
- \* Sleeping bag - Rated to -10F degrees below 0 or blankets in a lighter bag
- \* Sleeping pad
- \* Water bottle - Suggest a Nalgene wide mouth 32 oz.
- \* Scout Handbook
- \* Pencil
- \* Paper
- \* Scout Uniform and Neckerchief
- \* Scout Belt
- \* Flashlight & Extra Batteries
- \* First Aid kit: assorted band-aids, 2x2 gauze squares, tape, moleskin, non-latex gloves, scissors, antibiotic ointment, tweezers, antiseptic wipes, etc. See the Scout Handbook for more information.
- \* Toiletry Kit: toothpaste and toothbrush, comb, soap sunscreen, bug repellent, washcloth, hand towel, mirror, Toilet paper, etc.
